Smorkin Labbit

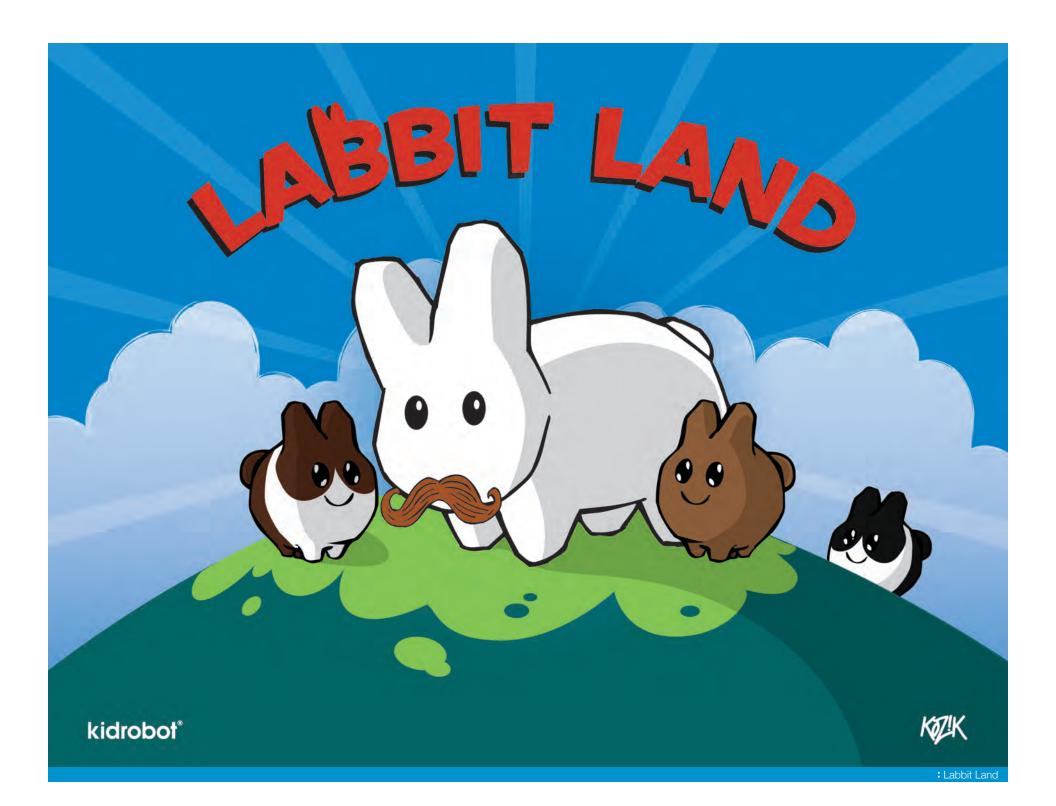

Hitting the runway hard and fast in its collaboration with Visionaire Magazine, Kidrobot produced Visionaire 44, toys designed by Marc Jacobs for Louis Vuitton, Valentino, Donatella Versace, Hedi Slimane, Miuccia Prada, Karl Lagerfeld, Jean-Louis Dumas for Hermes, Alexander McQueen, Dolce & Gabbana, and Viktor & Rolf. Kidrobot and Visionaire collaborated again in producing Visionaire 45 with Comme des Garcons, Maison Martin Margiela, Gucci, Vivienne Westwood, Christian Lacroix for Pucci, Giorgio Armani, John Galliano, Stefano Pilati for Yves Saint Laurent, Helmut Lang, and Jean-Paul Gaultier.

Continuing to seek out crossover collaborations, Kidrobot worked with popular street wear brand Diamond Supply Co. on a mascot mini-fig. Sporting a laid back pose with a skate deck, the Lil' Cutty figure had the iconic diamond head with the reverse pac-man eyes (a nod to the KR mascot). This was a perfect crossover piece for Diamond Supply Co. fans, sneakerheads, toy folk, and streetwear enthusiasts! It was released over a two week period, in two sizes 3.5" and 12", with exclusive color ways for Diamond Supply, PacSun, BAIT and Kidrobot.





Celebrating the 30th Anniversary of Jim Philips's famous "Screaming Hand" design, Santa Cruz Skateboards invited some of the world's most influential artists and brands to pay homage to this iconic image... and Kidrobot's contribution was a beautiful vinyl sculpture standing 11" tall. Released as a limited edition piece, it was also produced in blanks which were customized by a select number of artists and displayed in a mobile art gallery. The gallery is scheduled to visit several countries in 2016 and 2017.

Skullheads Skullheads are 12-inch figures produced exclusively by Kidrobot for fashion retailer Barneys New York. Toy designer Huck Gee's signature Skullhead was immaculately dressed in the Spring collections of five of the world's most famous fashion designers: Marc Jacobs, Jil Sander, Dries Van Noten, Rick Owens, and Duckie Brown. Each designer supplied the actual fabric used in their collection to ensure authenticity.

kidrobot x TARINA TARANTINO

Kidrobot collaborated with jewelry designer extraordinaire Tarina Tarantino to create a collection of limited edition jewelry and accessories. Each collaborative piece featured one or more of Kidrobot's iconic characters—MUNNY, Dunny and Kidrobot—and was punctuated by a rich selection of brilliant Swarovski crystals, vivid lucite beads, pearls, cast metal pendants and silk ribbons handpicked by Tarina Tarantino. Highlights included pink, blue and white multi-strand pearl and crystal necklaces with 4-inch MUNNY charms and beaded bracelets with vintage-style cast metal pieces.

New York City nightclub legend Peter Gatien set up shop in Toronto and launched CiRCA, a one-of-a-kind nightclub and entertainment venue. Kidrobot designed an exclusive room on the third floor of the space. A world's first, the bar and lounge area featured the colorful world of Kidrobot, including signature creations such as Dunny, MUNNY, and Frank Kozik's Smorkin' Labbit character.

Kidrobot and Burton Snowboards went full-on slopestyle to unveil their limited edition collaborative snowboard, the Burton Kidrobot 158 cm Custom Plus, and a series of limited edition outerwear for men and women. The result was a whimsical and colorful snowboard, with a top sheet graphic that featured a repeating pattern of Kidrobot's icon, Robot Head, and a base graphic photo collage of well-known Kidrobot figures. These patterns, "Toy Pile" and "Robot Head Jacquard," are also featured on the outerwear collection. Special components of the Burton x Kidrobot outerwear collection included printed satin linings, Riri multicolored zippers and custom Robot Head zipper pulls on all exposed zips. The collection was available in Burton stores around the world, Kidrobot stores in North America, select specialty retailers, and on kidrobot.com.

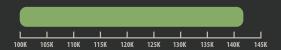
